


F-EXC-M METALLIZED DIRECT EXTRUSION FILM

Base polyester is one side EXC Chemical Coated and other side either Untreated Plasma Treated or Corona Treated. F-EXC-M is a metallized BOPET film available in optical densities ranging from 2.2 to 2.8 which gives the customer a diverse range of application options. The metallization is available on the Untreated surface (MU) giving a bond strength between the metal and the film a minimum of 100gm/25mm, on the Plasma Treated surface (MZ) giving a bond strength between the metal and the film an minimum of 150gm/25mm, or on the Corona treated surface (MT) giving a bond strength between the metal and the film a minimum of 130gm/25mm.

KEY FEATURES:

- No solvent emissions or residuals during extrusion coating
- No additional priming needed prior to extrusion

 Film is designed for direct extruded polyethylene adhesion without the need for primer
