- Start up and shut down equipment in accordance with operation's requirements, company safety procedures and OSHA requirements for machine activation and shutdown.
- Troubleshoot and repair electric controls, motor control centers, and programmable logic controls (Siemens).
- Analyze circuits, wiring diagrams and drawings to install, repair, calibrate, service and replace electronic devices and systems.
- Perform scheduled preventive maintenance tasks such as checking, cleaning, or repairing equipment to detect and prevent problems.
- Dismantle, inspect and replace electrical machinery and replaces defective electrical or mechanical parts.
- Apply knowledge of electrical systems, power distribution, PLC, calibrations, and other electronics related areas.

- Assist with mechanical troubleshooting of highly automated process equipment.
- Mentoring/training maintenance mechanical technicians and production operators.
- Maintain flexibility in work shift to support the plant needs.
- Analytical, critical thinker, problem solver, strong interpersonal and communications skills.

- Associate degree in Industrial Technology/Electrical/Mechanical Maintenance or similar field; or Journeyman Electrician license
- Minimum 5 years experience in industrial electrical maintenance in manufacturing environment
